Miss La Petite ~ Rules & Information

Age Limit: Open to girls between the ages of 3 & 5 years old as of September 29, 2018.

Entry Fee: \$30.00 due upon entry w/application. Fees will not be refunded for no-show.

Number of Contestants: The contest will automatically close when 30 entries have been accepted. Deadline for entry is Friday, September 14, 2018. In the event an entry form arrives at the Festival office after the contest has been declared closed, the applicant will be notified, and the entry fee will be returned.

Attire: Any style of tea-length dress or shorter is appropriate. **Full length dresses that cover the ankles and or shoes is prohibited.** Any contestant wearing a full-length dress will not be given a score for **“Dress”**.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2018 ~ JUDGING!

Judging: All judging will be completed on 9/30. Contestants will be judged on Interview, Dress, Personality, & Stage Presence. Winners will be announced on Youth Day.

Interview: at 9:30 a.m.

Be at East Chambers High School at 9:00 am. Each child will have a 2-minute interview with the judges. Contestants will be given a number from 1 to 30 and will be interviewed in that order. The contestant must be interviewed when her number is called or forfeit her turn. Only one adult per child will be allowed to stay in the holding room during the interview time. To ensure fairness, no one will be allowed to accompany a contestant into their interview.

On Stage: 11:00 a.m.

Following the interview portion, Miss La Petite contestants will remain in their dresses to be judged on stage. Judging will begin promptly at 11:00 a.m. As they walk out on stage the emcee will introduce them and give a bio from information submitted on their entry form. Family members and friends are invited to attend the onstage portion of the contest.

Check In: 11:30 a.m. – Meet at Prosperity Bank (rear parking lot) wearing the same dress that was worn the weekend before during judging. Contestants will be bussed to the Main Stage in the park for their final stage presentation. Parents/Guardians may accompany contestants on the bus to the festival grounds.

Line-up: Upon arrival when exiting the bus, **ONLY ONE ADULT PER CHILD** will be allowed in the line-up area behind the stage. Please ask your family and friends to wait in front of the stage in the viewing area. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Back stage is chaotic, and the amount of traffic flow must be kept at a minimum. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Miss La Petite Contest: 12:00 p.m. – Each contestant will be individually introduced and lined up on stage. After introductions the new Texas Rice Festival **Miss La Petite and Runners-ups** will be announced.

Youth Day Parade: All contestants are strongly encouraged to ride on the Miss La Petite float during Friday's parade. Please meet in front of the Community Building at the South end of the park at 2:15 p.m. to be placed on the float. An adult must ride with each child. Contestants will be dropped off in front of the Community Building after the parade. Miss La Petite and runners-up are to wear their dresses. All other contestants can wear their dress or official Miss La Petite t-shirt and shorts/jeans.

Grand Parade: 9:15 a.m. – Contestants wearing their Miss LaPetite t-shirt and shorts/jeans wishing to ride in the Grand Parade should meet at the corner of Pear Ave. and Hwy 124, across from First Baptist Church to be placed on floats. The Grand Parade starts at 10:00 a.m. Floats will unload in the East Chambers School parking lot. Parents you may pick up your child at that location immediately following the parade. For safety reasons **no one will be allowed to get off their float until it reaches the school.**
